There is currently a vacancy on Skeeby Parish Council.

The Council can now fill two vacancies by co-option, which is a process whereby the Council considers applications from interested persons and can then select someone to fill the seat.

Requirements

A Councillor must be:

- Over 18 years of age
- On the electoral register for Skeeby
- A person shall, unless disqualified by virtue of this Act or any other enactment, be qualified to be elected and to be a member of a local authority if they are a qualifying Commonwealth citizen or a citizen of the Republic of Ireland or in the case of a local authority in England, a qualifying EU citizen or an EU citizen with retained rights and on the relevant day they have attained the age of eighteen years)

The closing date for applications is Friday 20th June 2025. Applicants will be notified of the Council's decision after the next Parish Council meeting on Thursday 31st July 2025, which you are welcome to attend.
